## Domaine Robert Arnoux, Vosne-Romanée February 2010

Pascal Lachaux has turned this in to one of the very top domaines in Burgundy. We have done our own little spot of cherry picking and are delighted to be to offer these sensational wines, many of which are on offer at about the same prices as the current 2008 releases. For once, you can cherry pick away until your heart's content! Quantities are limited, mind, so first come first serve. The wines will arrive direct from the domaine's cellars in March. Burghound notes are included and he seems to find a lot of these wines "outstanding." There are some exceptional vintages here and some exceptional wines, both for drinking and keeping. Fill your boots.

### 1999 Vosne Romanée 1er Cru Chaumes

£795ib/6 mags 3 cases

*"Dark ruby color, quite concentrated with copious amounts of Vosne spice, powerful, concentrated flavors and good length."*

### 1999 Vosne Romanée 1er Cru Reignots

£495ib/3 mags 3 cases

*"Beautifully elegant black cherry fruits and Vosne spice combined with supple, complex and rich flavors. Impressive length and excellent overall balance. Terrific."*

### 2000 Vosne Romanée 1er Cru Suchots

£575ib/3 mags 3 cases

*"Crushed black fruits and delicious yet serious flavors underpinned by rounded tannins and outstanding length. This has already opened and developed considerably since I last tasted it from barrel and this is seductive, spicy, classy and altogether elegant. Understated and fine and this completely coats the palate. A first rate effort for the vintage. Outstanding."*

### 2001 Echézeaux Grand Cru

£595ib/3 mags 2 cases

*"Also quite spicy but with rounder, slightly bigger and more powerful flavors that display outstanding intensity. This is delicious in the best sense of the word and offers more finesse than Echézeaux usually does and finishes with a good lashing of ripe tannins."*

### 2002 Vosne Romanée 1er Cru Reignots

£945ib/6 mags 2 cases

*"Stunningly elegant and expressive with superb and abundant Vosne spice notes of terrific complexity that lead to detailed, refined, precise flavors blessed with plenty of black fruit extract and notable length. The tannins are extremely refined yet there is plenty of structure to permit this to age for a good 15 years, perhaps longer because the balance is exceptional. Outstanding"*

### 2002 Echézeaux Grand Cru

£1295ib/6 mags 2 cases

*"Intense black fruit followed by supple, round, delicious and pure flavors that don't quite have the same density as the Clos de Vougeot but more elegance and certainly plenty of punch. This finishes with sweetness and outstanding length."*

**2005 Vosne Romanée 1er Cru Chaumes****£795ib/12 bts****10 cases**

*"A background note of wood sets off the spicy black Vosne-styled fruit that complements well the textured, concentrated and sweet flavors that possess real volume and are exceptionally rich yet remain balanced on detailed on the sappy, velvety and generous finish. This is a really lovely example of Chaumes, which rarely gets the respect accorded to most other Vosne 1ers yet this is first rate. Outstanding."*

**2006 Romanée Saint Vivant Grand Cru****£1450ib/6 bts****5 cases**

*"A relatively high-toned spicy red and black fruit pinot liqueur nose of real class and elegance merges seamlessly into fresh, vibrant and detailed flavors brimming with both minerality and an underlying sense of tension that adds real energy to the perfectly balanced and gorgeously long finish that doesn't quite have the overall depth of the 2007 but it's not far off either. This should age well for up to a decade, perhaps a bit longer and should be worth the wait though I take pains to note however that it will certainly be capable of holding for much longer. A wine of obvious breed and class."*

**2007 Vosne Romanée 1er Cru Chaumes****£295ib/6 bts****2 cases**

*"Subtle spice notes add interest to the airy, elegant and very pure black and blue berry fruit that always carries a whiff of warm earth with it and this sense of refinement continues onto the round, sappy and mouth coating flavors that possess a real sense of volume to them, all wrapped in a long finish brimming with dry extract. This is very Vosne in style and character. Lovely stuff."*

**2007 Vosne Romanée 1er Cru Suchots****£595ib/6 bts****4 cases**

*"Wonderfully spicy, pure and almost wafting aromas of primarily black fruit but fruit that carries ample spice elements to it that are also picked up by the suave, velvety and lightly mineral infused medium weight plus flavors brimming with dry extract on the mouth coating finish where a touch of wood resurfaces. This is not as impressively scaled as the Echézeaux or as powerful but it's actually finer and more seductively textured. A great Suchots. Don't miss. Outstanding."*

**2007 Romanée Saint-Vivant Grand Cru****£1595ib/6 bts****2 cases**

*"In contrast to the wonderfully layered nose of the Suchots, here the profile runs much more toward the floral side of the aromatic spectrum with intense violet and rose petal notes that are overtly spicy while displaying touch of crushed red berries, hoisin and soy, all of which can be found on the pure, refined, intense and energetic middle weight flavors that are precise, minerally and linear, all wrapped in an explosive finish that seems to go on and on. A 'wow' wine and one of the best wines of the vintage. Don't miss."*
