## Domaine Bosquet des Papes

### 2005 Châteauneuf-du-Pape

Big, rich and spicy Grenache-based wine that makes a great match for red meat dishes. "The 2005 Châteauneuf-du-Pape exhibits the classic seaweed, salty ocean breeze-like notes intermixed with lavender, garrigue, kirsch, and spice." Parker

### 2007 Châteauneuf-du-Pape

Best 'basic' Châteauneuf-du-Pape ever made at the domaine. Super tannins and lovely concentration. "A blend of 75% Grenache, 12% Mourvedre, 10% Syrah, and the rest Vaccarese, Counoise, and Cinsault. It displays beautiful black cherry and plum-like fruit, with a gorgeous nose of nori (the seaweed wrappers used in sushi restaurants) intermixed with pepper, lavender, and spice. Very Provencal and full-bodied, with beautiful fruit purity and stunning density and personality, it should drink well for 10-12 years. 90-92 pts." Parker

### 2004 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Cuvée Chante Le Merle

"This has the deepest color of the three 2004s, a dark crimson, and offers up sweet garrigue notes intermixed with ground pepper, black cherry liqueur, and some raspberry and earth. It is rich, full-bodied, but again supple and silky, so drinking it during its first 8-10 years of life is recommended. 91 pts." Parker.

### 2007 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Cuvée Gloire de Mon Grand Père (Cuvée Grenache)

"From 60- to 70-year-old vines (98% Grenache and 2% Cinsault and the white grape Clairette, which always accounts for the slightly lighter color of this wine). It also comes from one of the hallowed sectors of Chateauneuf du Pape in the north called Gardioles, which has clay soils overlaid with small boulders. This wine displays the classic Grenache character of pure kirsch liqueur mixed with licorice and a hint of resinous pine needles. Dark ruby, deep, full-bodied, and incredibly sexy and seductive, I could have drunk this wine directly from one of the foudres, This has terrific fruit and is a brilliant expression of naked Grenache from a great terroir. It should drink well for 10-15 years. 91-93 pts." Parker.
